

GOD IS FAITHFUL BIBLE STUDY

One thing the Bible talks about a lot is that GOD IS FAITHFUL.

We hear that a lot, and when we're having a good day, we know it's true.

But when things go wrong, often it's hard to remember GOD IS FAITHFUL.

Why is it so hard to remember?

Well, first of all, when things go wrong, we start expecting the worst. We forget about all the good things that have happened in our lives. We become laser-focused on the bad that's right in front of us.

The world doesn't help, either. We have all been hurt at some point by somebody. How many times do we hear of people who don't keep their word, who don't do what they say? Even the people we trust the most, who are really trying to be faithful, often they fail to do what they intend to do. We all sin. We all make mistakes. We make good plans, but we fail.

When people let us down, it's easy to expect that God will do the same.

But God is not like that. He never fails. He has no sin. He does not make mistakes. Not ever! GOD IS ALWAYS FAITHFUL. He is not like the world. He is perfect.

When things go wrong, we need to stop and remember: There are a lot of good things going on around us too.

The enemy doesn't want us to look at the good things, or to remember God is faithful. So we need to look right past the enemy. We need to focus on God, and remember He is faithful.

The Bible verses on the next page are a great reminder of God's faithfulness. (And there are many more verses in the Bible about God's faithfulness – these are just a few!) Spend some time reading and reflecting on these verses when you're having a good day. Write notes to remind yourself of what these verses mean to you.

Then when you're having a bad day, look at these verses and your notes. And remember: GOD IS FAITHFUL. And He loves you so much!

BIBLE VERSES THAT REMIND US GOD IS FAITHFUL

(1) As you read each Bible verse, ask yourself what this verse means to you. Write what it means to you, in your own words.

(2) Remember a time when God was faithful to you – when He provided for you, when He gave you a blessing, when He helped you, when He comforted you. Take a moment to thank Him for being faithful.

(3) Pray and ask God to help you remember He is faithful. Ask Him to write it on your heart: GOD IS FAITHFUL!

(4) Write a note to yourself (that you can read later, whenever you have a bad day) reminding yourself that GOD IS FAITHFUL.

Philippians 4:19 – And my God will fully satisfy every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Psalms 36:5 – Your steadfast love, O LORD, extends to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds.

Lamentations 3:22-23 – The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

1 Corinthians 1:9 – God is faithful; by him you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

2 Thessalonians 3:3 – But the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one.

Psalms 91:4 – He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.

Hebrews 11:1 – Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

Exodus 34:6 – The LORD passed before him, and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness,

Romans 4:21 – Being fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised.

Joshua 21:45 – Not one of all the good promises that the LORD had made to the house of Israel had failed; all came to pass.
